INTERNATIONAL MASTERCLASSES FOR CONDUCTORS

This year, the conducting masterclasses will take place in Tallinn and Pärnu from **12 July to 23 July 2025**. At the same time, Pärnu will host master classes for string, wind and percussion players. Musicians from Järvi Academy Sinfonietta, Pärnu City Orchestra, and Järvi Academy Youth Symphony Orchestra.

Pärnu International Music Festival will take place 16–25 July 2025.

- 2 YouTube links, each video lasting 10 minutes. Recordings may include mergers of repertoires.
- An edited biography for the program booklet.
- A photo in JPG format (high-resolution).
- An advance payment of $\in 80$ is required upon registration. NB! Failure to make the payment will result in the registration not being considered.

Active participant

16 active participants will be selected, and their work programme will include:

- At least 100 minutes of work with pianos and various orchestras of the Järvi Academy (12 July 23 July 2025).
- Conducting two concerts in Tallinn and Pärnu. Participants will be selected by the tutors on the day before the concert. Each active participant can conduct at least one concert. The organiser does not guarantee an equal number of concerts for all participants.
- Lectures.

Active participants will be selected for the courses by Paavo Järvi.

Sessions will be held at MUBA (Pärnu mnt 59, Tallinn) and Pärnu Concert Hall (Aida 4, Pärnu). Participants are allowed to film all sessions.

Student

Two *students* will be selected with a work progamme including:

- At least 50 minutes of work with pianos and various orchestras of the Järvi Academy (12 July 23 July 2025).
- Concerts in Tallinn and Pärnu. Generally, *students* do not conduct at the concerts, but there have been exceptions.
- Lectures.

Passive participant

Those who receive a negative answer can participate as **passive applicants**, with a work programme including:

- One podium time with Leonid Grin (with pianos).
- Lectures.

Observers:

Guests are welcome to attend the masterclasses as observers. The fee is \notin 30 per day, payable in cash on the spot.

We will publish the concert programme at the end of 2024.
